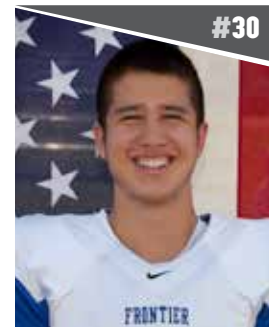

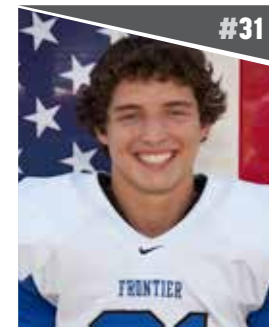

2014 FRONTIER TITANS SEASON PREVIEW

Last season Frontier struggled to a 4-6 finish, missing out on the playoffs, and falling short of our goal to defend the SWYL championship. This season, a young group of *Titans* will attempt to get us back on track, and into the title picture, in what promises to be a loaded SWYL. This year's team is led by senior offensive lineman **Blake Pierce** and defensive back **Riley Salters**. The *Titans* will be big up front offensively, and should be strong in the running game with senior transfer **Isaiah Sharp** running the ball. **Brady Serda** is the top returning receiver on offense, while junior **Elijah Hill** and sophomore **Greg Youngblood** will compete for snaps at quarterback. On the defensive side of the ball the *Titans* will depend heavily on seniors **Joe Duncan**, **Jason Quinton**, and **Nick Santoro**, while getting big contributions from juniors **Dominic Demarco**, **Daylyn Jackson**, and **Isaiah Atuatasi**.

This year's schedule will again be a tough one. The SWYL has proven to be one of the top leagues in the state, and may be better than ever this season. The non-league slate is full of tough local teams, and a Fresno area power, which should prepare the *Titans* for the speed they will see when league starts.

8/29 The *Titans* host the *Ridgeview Wolfpack* – Coach **Dennis Manning** says this is the best team he has ever coached, and he has been around a while. Last season the *Wolfpack* competed for the *Division III* title with a group that was mostly juniors. This season they return 75% of their starters and added **Sheldon Coney** to their stable of really good backs. *Ridgeview* moved up to *D2* this year, and is a serious contender for that title.

9/12 Frontier hosts former SWYL member *Independence* in week 2. The *Falcons* boast a balanced offense that can run the option and throw the ball effectively. Defensively they run an aggressive stack defense that looks to create big plays.

9/19 The *Titans* will travel to *Golden Valley* to play the *Bulldogs* for the 1st time in history. *Golden Valley* is a program that is loaded with good athletes and likes to throw the ball. This will be a very good test for the *Titan's* secondary.

9/26 *Homecoming 2014* will see *Frontier* hosting the *West High Vikings*. The *Vikings* have a long legacy of speed and athleticism. *West High* had more players (3) on NFL rosters last season than the rest of *Kern County* combined.

10/3 *Frontier* takes its longest trip of the year to face off against *Fresno Central*. *Central* sent seven players to *Division 1* colleges last season, and is one of the premier programs in the *Central Valley*. Always a contender for the *D1* title, *Central* competes in the *TRAC*, which is the top league in the northern part of the section.

10/10 The *Titans* open SWYL play with the *Liberty Patriots*. **Bryan Nixon's Patriot** squad is stacked at every position. They are big on the offensive line, tall and fast at wide receiver, and have a division one athlete in the backfield. Defensively they fly to the ball and create a lot of turnovers. This is definitely one of the top programs in the entire state this year. The *Patriots* will have to come to *Titan Stadium* to continue the classic "*Black and Blue*" rivalry series. *Frontier* will be looking to avenge an overtime loss last season, which cost them the big game trophy.

At halftime, *Frontier* will honor the memory of **Ted Agu** by retiring his jersey. **Ted** was a two time captain for the *Titans*, all area defensive end, and three sport athlete at *Frontier* who graduated with a 3.7 GPA in 2010. He walked on at *Cal* and earned a scholarship there to play football. We lost **Ted** earlier this year in a tragic accident. His coaches and former teammates want to celebrate **Ted's** life, the effort he put into it, and the great friend and person he was. This will be a special night.

10/17 Out of the frying pan and into the fire, the *Titans* travel to play the defending state champ *Drillers* at historic *Griffith Field*. *BHS* never slows down and never rebuilds, they just reload. Match-ups make fights, and *Frontier* has always given *BHS* a good game. The last time the two teams met at *Griffith Field*, the *Titans* came from behind to beat the *Drillers* 28-21.

10/24 *Stockdale* travels to *Frontier* in our third game in the SWYL slate. The *Mustangs* are changing from a Wing T based offense to a Spread under new coach **Brett Sheldon**. The *Mustangs* have always had some of the best athletes in town, so it will be interesting to see how well they make the transition.

10/31 New SWYL arrival *Garces'* arrival just makes our league that much tougher. The *Rams* have dominated *Division Two* for the last few years, and are also breaking in a new coach. A program with a rich tradition of excellence, expect *Garces* to be in the mix this season.

11/7 *Frontier* will close the season at arch rival *Centennial*. The *Golden Hawks* return most of their roster from last season, including their 1,000 yard running back and quarterback. Coach **Kevin Sneed** has over 100 wins to his credit, and really knows how to prepare his squad. This will be a tough, physical game that will be critical for playoff seeding.

WEEK ZERO GAME

The *Titans* and Ridgeview *Wolf Pack* tangled at BC as part of the *Kickoff Classic*, put on by the Kern High School District. Though competitive early, the *Wolf Pack* pulled away with a late first half surge and ended up beating Frontier 42-21. The *Titans* have been working hard to fix all the issues that Ridgeview exposed. Last week Ridgeview proved their win was not a fluke by crushing Liberty by the identical score.

THIS WEEK'S GAME

Frontier plays host to the Independence *Falcons* to open up a new year of football at *Titan Stadium*. The *Falcons* got beat in week one by the Arroyo Grande *Eagles*, a tough southern section team. This will be a huge game as each team tries to get a "W" in the win column and back on track.

NEXT WEEK'S GAME

The *Titans* travel to face Golden Valley for the first time. The *Bulldogs* put up over 60 points in week one of the season, while shutting out Mira Monte. With the ability to run the ball as well as throw it, Golden Valley will be a stiff test for us. Be sure to take the short drive south on the 99 to check out their facilities (they look a lot like ours) and enjoy the game.

NEXT HOME GAME

Two weeks from tonight Frontier will be celebrating *Homecoming 2014* with a game against the West High *Vikings*. Nobody does *Homecoming* like Frontier, so be sure to get here early to enjoy the floats, the pageantry and the *Titan Pride* which will be on full display.
